Buses*	There are 2 buses which pass near to the school on Sycamore Rd and Reading rd with services 414 and Buzz 41. The 41 service is hourly and could be used for travel to school whereas the times for the 414 service are not suitable for our school.
Rail*	Farnborough is served by two train stations Farnborough Main and Farnborough North both served by South West trains. the main station is 1.5 miles from the school, a 26 minute bus ride or a 35 minute walk, thus only making this an option for staff travel.
Roads*	The main entrance to the school is at the end of Cunnington Road which is a cul de sac accessed via Sycamore Road. This is a busy main road running north to south and which connects to the A331 Blackwater Valley Relief Road. The pedestrian access path to the rear of the school site is off The Grove which is a narrow residential road with blind bends. Reading Road used to have a crossing patrol due to being a busy main road, however, the crossing patrol is no longer in place. This is the main route between the Infant and the Junior School sites.

Cycling Routes*	There are no designated cycle routes to the school, however, there are off-road paths through the park that can be used.

As we have an island roundabout outside school parents use this as a 'kiss and drop' although the road markings indicate that it is illegal to do so.
